YOUR CONNECTION

Your Connection provides access to your eServices username and password, financial aid, grades, and registration for classes. Before classes start, you will receive information in the mail with Your Connection ID and PIN. You can access Your Connection at: https://connect.fredonia.edu/

eSERVICES

Your eServices ID is used for logging into the campus wireless network, computer labs, FREDApps, FREDmail, and OnCourse. COMPUTER LAB PRINTING
